We, the members of St. Philip's Evangelical Lutheran Church, would like to express our tremendous gratitude to you for allowing us to assist you in the Christian and academic education of your children. It is a privilege we do not take lightly.

Since its establishment in 1958, St. Philip's Evangelical Lutheran School has faithfully served as a Christ-centered educational institution. We celebrate the countless lives that have been touched by the dedicated efforts of our staff, teachers, and administrators, and the continual support of parents, alumni, and congregation members.

In recent years, like many other schools, we have been struggling with teacher shortages and teacher retention. In the past, St. Philip's has had years where we've had enough teachers but not enough students. Now, St. Philip's is experiencing both a teacher and student shortage. Despite our collective efforts to sustain our school, these challenges have made it increasingly difficult to maintain the level of excellence and commitment our mission demands and that our students and families deserve.

Therefore, after much prayer and deliberation, an assessment of our school's staffing and enrollment trends, and long-term viability, it has been determined that our school is no longer able to continue offering the level of quality education we have been known for.

It is with heavy hearts that we, St. Philip's Evangelical Lutheran Congregation and Board of Education, are sharing with you the results of our January 19th, 2025, congregational meeting. **This school year** (2024-2025) will be our final year of school here at St. Philip's.

Please know we are committed to assisting our school families in finding alternative educational options that align with our Christian values and meet our scholar's needs. Although there is no ideal time to share this type of news, we are grateful this timing will allow our families to enroll in a new school for 2025-2026 when choice open enrollment begins again on February 3. Please look for a separate communication from the school office with more information about school options and open enrollment.

We kindly request that any questions regarding the decision to close be directed to Pastor Kimbrough.

We invite you to join us in prayer as we navigate this season of closure. As it is written in Ecclesiastes 3:1, "To everything there is a season, and a time to every purpose under heaven."

We trust in God's sovereign plan and remain confident that the seeds planted here will bear fruit in the lives of all who have been part of St. Philip's Evangelical Lutheran School. May God guide us in faith, hope, and love as we move forward.
