Monday - Pajama Day

Wear pajamas, robes, sweatpants, shorts, etc.

Clothing should be appropriate. Please no tank tops, boxers, or anything you wouldn't feel comfortable wearing in front of Jesus. Also, because pajamas are often thin, wearing clothes underneath would be a good idea.

Tuesday - Twin Day

Plan ahead to wear a matching outfit with someone else, or a group of people. You could even match with a staff member. Twin with colors or matching clothes.

Wednesday - Sports Day

Show support for your favorite sports team (high school, college, or professional) or sport (basketball, football, baseball, soccer, etc.)

Thursday - Throwback Day

Wear clothes worn in a previous decade ('90s, '80s, '60s, '40s, '20s, etc.)

Friday - St. Philip's Warrior Day

Go all out in SP clothes and SP gear. You could also wear St. Philip's colored clothes - Red, White, & Navy Blue.

When participating, please make sure to dress appropriately. Clothing should not be too tight, too loose, or revealing. Students who choose not to dress up, are required to wear their school uniform. Open Enrollment

Enrollment for the 2025-2026 school year began on Monday, February 3, 2025.

The first open enrollment period ends February 20, 2025.

You have the best chance if you apply in the first open enrollment period to secure a seat at your preferred school.

Waiting until later enrollment periods will more than likely put you on a waiting list.

We encourage our families to enroll during the first open enrollment period.

<u>Illness Reminder</u> - Students who are sick and/or displaying symptoms of illness should not come to school. If you are in doubt, keep your child out for a day. A child with a fever should not return to school until 24 fever-free hours have passed without the aid of medication.
